Call for Papers for Conference Track on
“Transdisciplinarity and Knowledge Transfer Across Sectors”

The discourse on transdisciplinarity relies heavily on the insights of theory, practice, learning, application, and policy-making that tie theories about transdisciplinarity to the implementation, application, and dissemination of knowledge to inform real-world problems. Transferring knowledge across sectors that strive to address global ‘wicked problems’ of our age is a distinguishing tenet of transdisciplinary activity and scholarship. The observation and measurement of how knowledge is transferred across sectors are critical to the advancement of transdisciplinary theory as a framework for global problem-solving that utilized diverse perspectives and approaches to frame unifying models that address common and complex problems facing humanity today.
